Personal data transferred to the CIBERER Biobank will be treated in accordance with the provisions of the General Regulation (EU) 2016/679, of the European Parliament and of the Council, of April 27, 2016, on the Protection of natural persons with regard to the treatment of personal data and the free circulation of these data, which entered into force on May 25, 2018.
